

Information for Contact Lens Wearers

Since the contact lens fitting services are in addition to a basic eye exam, the following information is provided to avoid any confusion. Some insurance plans cover all or a portion of the contact lens fitting fee, but some insurances (including BCBS) do not cover the fitting at all.

The following list explains the service fees for the majority of our contact lens fits. If you have any questions regarding what is covered by your insurance plan, please don't hesitate to ask the staff prior to your exam.

Experienced wearers

Spherical soft contact lens fitting	\$65
Toric soft contact lens fitting	\$85
Bifocal or monovision soft contact lens fitting	\$130
Standard rigid gas permeable fit	\$150
Rigid gas permeable bifocal or monovision fit	\$200
Specialty fits (bitoric, keratoconic, scleral lenses)	ask

Never worn contacts before

If you have never worn contacts before, you will need training on insertion, removal and care of your lenses. There is a one time additional fee of \$50 for this service.
